**POSTING NOTIFICATION**


This information is to be posted for a **minimum of 30** days in areas accessible to inmates and shall be made available to inmates who do not have access to posted copies.

**PROCEDURE**

Due to the Department's recent conversion to a stamp-less postage system, concerns have been raised regarding inmates with previously purchased stamps in their possession. Any inmates who still have U.S./domestic postage stamps will be permitted to use these stamps over the next six months, effective today.

After this 180-day period, the stamps will be considered contraband. Only international stamps will continue to be sold in the Commissary.
