Statement on offender Salvador Medina

Phoenix, Ariz.- Offender Salvador Medina was released from ASPC - Eyman Aug. 6, which was his scheduled and mandatory release date.

Medina was driven to the Southern Parole office on 16th Street and was out-processed by his parole officer, which included being fitted with a GPS ankle monitor. He departed the office at approximately noon. This GPS tracking system monitor is designed to notify the parole office electronic monitoring device by e-mail if an offender has gone beyond the range of the offender's residence between 8 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. After he departed the office, Medina removed the monitor from his ankle.

The Arizona Department of Corrections is reviewing its policies and procedures as well as the technology of the monitoring system.
