1 staff, 12 inmates injured in Marana prison fight

Marana, Az - A large disturbance involving as many as 150 Arizona minimum security inmates housed in a private prison in Marana ended with one staff member and 12 inmates receiving minor injuries.

The fight broke out before 10 p.m. Wednesday but was contained within about one hour. A 20-member tactical unit from Arizona State Prison Complex – Tucson responded to help quell the disturbance.

The Marana Community Correctional Treatment Facility houses 500 Arizona minimum security inmates and is owned and operated by Management and Training Corp., based in Centerville, Utah.

The one MTC staff member and 12 inmates were treated onsite.

The cause of the fight is under investigation. The prison will remain on lockdown until further notice.
