Tucson inmate leaves work crew

Tucson, Az.- Inmate Jeffrey Douglas (ADC #58263) walked away from a Tucson city work crew shortly after noon Wednesday.

A Tucson city crew supervisor notified the Arizona Department of Corrections at about 12:30 p.m. that Douglas was not at his work location. Douglas was last accounted for at 12:05 p.m.

Douglas, who came to ADC for his second commitment in October 2009, is serving a 7.5-year sentence for theft of means of transportation and misconduct involving a weapon. The weapon's charge stems from being a felon in possession of a weapon. Douglas is a minimum security inmate housed in the Whetstone Unit at the Arizona State Prison Complex - Tucson. He originally came to the department in May 1986 for three years on a theft charge.

The Tucson Police Department and ADC were notified immediately by the crew supervisor. ADC dispatched personnel, including canine teams from prisons in Tucson, Douglas and Florence.
